Any student who has been on **long suspension** or **more than one short suspension** in the current year will have their **entitlement reviewed** by the principal.

Any student who has **unpaid fees** from previous years and or has made minimal attempt to pay some fees in the current year or negotiate a payment plan will have their entitlement reviewed by the Principal.

Any student who wishes to discuss any aspect of this table of expectation or requests additional support in meeting the school's core expectations should speak to their Year Adviser or Year Head Teacher well in advance of any school activity.

The excursion organiser will consult the Year Head Teacher, Year Adviser and Deputy Principal for student data in relation to student core expectations achievement.
